

# Warwick River Christian School

## Accreditation Objectives and Strategies

April 2005

**Objective I:** By June 2010, WRCS students will demonstrate Christ-like attitudes of honesty, fairness, and respect for self and others, measured by:

1. 80% of students (grades 1-8) receive a Satisfactory Conduct or above on quarterly report cards.
  2. 33% reduction of reportable incidents to the principal.
  3. 25% reduction of visits for behavioral reasons to the Accountability Room (gr. 1-5 only).
- Strategy A: We will emphasize school-wide character development.
  - Strategy B: We will form a comprehensive school-wide discipline plan.
  - Strategy C: We will enlarge our support system for counseling of students.

**Objective II:** By June 2010, students will participate in academic experiences that enhance God-given talents, measured by:

1. 75% of students will volunteer to participate based upon teacher recommendation.
  2. 90% of parents of recommended students will support involvement by their children.
- Strategy A: We will provide enhanced academic activities that will promote critical thinking, problem solving, and analysis.
  - Strategy B: We will utilize resources beyond the standard classroom program to challenge identified students.

**Objective III:** By June 2010, students will demonstrate appropriate age and grade-level learning based on comprehensive standards and skill for each successive grade-level, evidenced by:

1. 78% scoring at 50 percentile or more on the *Stanford 10 Basic Battery* (Grades 1-8).
  2. 90% passing the *Scott-Foresman Reading End of Year test*.
  3. 97% receiving passing grades or above in all academic subjects. (We will maintain or exceed baseline percentage.)
- Strategy A: We will develop school-wide Math standards and skills.
  - Strategy B: We will develop school-wide Bible standards and skills.
  - Strategy C: We will develop school-wide Technology standards and skills.
  - Strategy D: We will develop school-wide Language Arts standards and skills.
  - Strategy E: We will develop school-wide Science standards and skills.
  - Strategy F: We will develop school-wide Social Studies standards and skills.
