Payment Policies

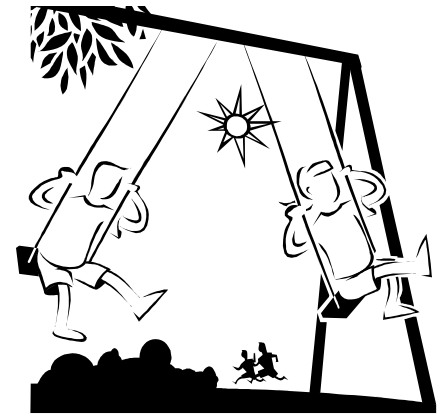
Here are the main points of the Mennonite expression of Christianity.

Thank you for your interest in Warwick River Christian Child Care. This Parent Handbook should answer many of the questions you may have about the services we offer.

Our child care center has a large multi-use room with additional space available as needed in the modular behind the child care building. We provide organized activities and supervised play time, both indoors and outdoors. The playground provides plenty of equipment and open space for large motor development.

We seek to provide an educational and wholesome environment with a Christian approach. We are operating under a Commonwealth of Virginia exemption clause offered to facilities operated by a religious organization. As such, we are required to comply with all applicable fire, safety, and health standards.

Play Time

We encourage the children to use their imagination during free play time. The large play area allows for creative play with blocks, dolls, and dress-up clothes. We encourage them to play gently with each other to allow children of all ages to play together. We do not allow pretend fighting or gunplay.

Clothing and Personal Items

Please have your child bring a back pack for notes, etc. A second set of play clothes should be kept here at all times in case of an accident. Please check occasionally to see if they are adequate for the present weather season. Include extra socks and underpants, just in case.

Children Who Become Ill

We do not have the facilities to care for sick children. Please keep your child home for 24 hours after they have had vomiting, diarrhea or a fever. If your child becomes sick while at child care, we will call you to come and pick them up as soon as possible.

Discipline Policies

Please review the following rules.

Physical contact causing discomfort is not permitted. Severe or excessive hitting, kicking, pinching, pushing, spitting, scratching, or biting is unacceptable behavior. The child will immediately be removed to time out or, in severe cases, to the director's office. The first time a child bites another person, a note and phone call will be made to the parents of each person involved. Depending upon the severity of the bite, or if it is repeated, the parent of the child doing the biting will be asked to take the child home.

Children who continue to hurt the other children or the staff, will be asked to leave the child care and not return.

Children are not allowed to engage in "pretend" violence, such as gunplay or martial arts. "Time out" is often used to give a child space when a discipline problem occurs.

"Time out" equals one minute for each year in the child's age.

Marking, defacing or destroying child care property is not permitted.

Operating Hours and Days Closed

Our child care center is open from 6:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday throughout the year. We are normally closed on the following days:

- ◇ New Year's Day (or nearest adjacent weekday)
- ◇ Memorial Day (Monday observance)
- ◇ July 4th (or nearest federally observed weekday)
- ◇ Labor Day
- ◇ Thanksgiving Day (and the Friday after)
- ◇ Christmas Eve until New Years.

The child care *may* be closed during Spring Break or other government holidays.

In general, the child care will remain open during poor weather. If in doubt, call the child care. We have skilled staff on duty during all operating hours. All regular staff are First Aid certified.

PLEASE PICK UP YOUR CHILDREN BEFORE 6 PM, to allow our staff members to close on time and to be with their families

Meals and Snacks

We do not provide breakfast. You are welcome, however to supply a box of cereal, oatmeal, pop tarts etc. We will supply the milk, sugar, butter.

We serve a nutritious snack at 9:30 a.m. and at 3:15 p.m. We also serve a well-balanced lunch at 11:30 a.m.
